Sacrificial Giving – UPDATE

Thank you for your strong positive response to closing our \$30,000 budget gap. Since our pleas, contributions have jumped significantly and now total \$13,200 above our 2007 – 2008 budget, so we are almost halfway there. We appreciate your commitment to our 2008 Sacrificial Giving campaign. Through January 23 we have received 293 pledges for an average of \$1,593. This is an increase of 11%, near the 15% pledge jump we required to balance our budget and be a brighter “light on the hill”. We use your pledges to drive our 2008-2009 budget, so please pledge in the next two weeks if you have not already done so. When seventy more of you commit to a 10-15% increase, we will take a major step towards restoring St. Anne’s financial health in our 100th anniversary year.
