Safe Environment Once again, we want to remind you about this important program launched last spring by the archdiocese to train all parish/school employees and all volunteers with on-going unsupervised contact with children (acronym OUCH) and vulnerable adults in the prevention of sexual abuse. **This training must be completed by May 31 of this year.** If you are an "OUCH" volunteer (**CYO coach, religious ed teacher, Cabrini minister, playground assistant, field trip driver, etc.**), please go the archdiocesan website, www.seattlearch.org, find the Safe Environment tab, and sign up for training. If you have trouble with the website or don't have a computer, call the Parish Office. We must take very seriously our responsibility to protect our children and, this training is also important in protecting our volunteers. It would be tragic to unwittingly do something that was misinterpreted and led to allegations of abuse.
