If you haven't already done so, take a look at our recently restored St. Francis Garden on the First Ave. W. side of our parish campus, next to the Parish Office. This part of our grounds had once been a vegetable garden school project, but had for the past several years not been tended. It required a huge amount of work just to keep the overgrowth cut back, and had become a real eyesore. A parish family—who has asked to remain anonymous—made a generous donation to pay for the clearing and landscaping.
