Safe Environment Training: St. Anne is providing another opportunity for you to attend the Safe Environment Training at Banchemo Hall on **June 11 from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.** The archdiocese has made this a mandatory training for all CYO coaches, in addition to the Play Like a Champion Training. If you don't have these trainings, you can't coach. Without qualified coaches, we will not be able to offer athletic opportunities to our kids as we have in the past. Please make the time to attend this training. It is designed to teach participants how to recognize the signs of abuse, how to respond to suspected abuse and how to keep our ministries, programs and schools safe.
