Initiative 1000, which is on this November's ballot, would legalize physician assisted suicide in Washington State.

The not-so-subtle message is that being older, disabled, poor or otherwise unable to manage for ourselves makes us a burden to others. But the reality is that situations are burdensome, not people. The solution to these burdensome situations is not, as I-1000 proposes, to prematurely end the life of the person. We must address the problem by providing loving, compassionate care at the end of life.
