Are You Good with Plants? Can You Help?

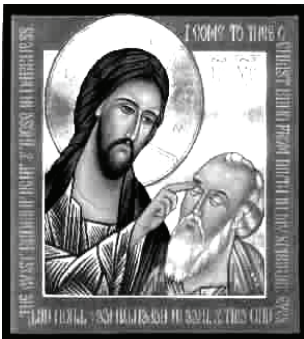
