I am pleased to announce that we are in the process of acquiring a new crucifix for our church. Jennifer & Michael Hyde and their children, Kathryn, Joseph and Michael, have made a donation in memory of their father and grandfather, Barney Hyde.

We have commissioned artist Alexandre Safonov to carve a life-sized corpus for a cross that will hang at the east end of the church. Alexandre is an accomplished artist who has created many crucifixes, statues and other religious pieces, including a life-sized statue of the Virgin and Child for Palisades Retreat Center. He approaches his religious works as prayer, and has specifically asked that our community pray for him and his work as he creates this crucifix for our parish. It is hoped that the corpus will be completed by this fall.
