Facility Focus

Several parishioners have asked about the new sound system for the church. As you know, this was to be accomplished if we received sufficient rebate monies from the 2009 Annual Catholic Appeal. If all pledges are fulfilled, St. Anne's Parish will receive \$27,401.00, thanks to many parishioners' generous support of the Archdiocese and St. Anne. Through Jan. 14th we are short of that amount by \$5,228.00. It is our hope that pledge fulfillments will be 100% so we will be able to move forward with this much needed improvement to the sound quality of our music and liturgies.

With the much appreciated help of our Pastoral Assistant for Music, Paul Kramer, I have investigated and counseled with numerous companies, searching for the correct system to work in our challenging church environment; the end goal being to install one that deals correctly with the echoes created by the many hard surfaces of the floor, walls and ceiling. All this needs to fall within the budget of the rebate monies. During this search we happened upon David Allen who recommended and installed the new system at St. Joseph Church. He has agreed to assist us in our selection and installation provided he does not have to complete all the wiring and mounting labor he had to do there. Both Paul and I have agreed to do his bidding on these tasks which will help reduce the labor costs, allowing us to spend more on higher end equipment. We hope to have an accounting for what the final costs will be within the next several weeks. I will keep you informed of our progress.

Thank you again for all that you do, or are about to do.

U.S. Census Bureau Hiring Census Takers

The U.S. Census Bureau is conducting its decennial count of the entire population of the United States in 2010. As a result, the Seattle Local Census Office is currently recruiting for temporary, part-time census taker positions across the city. These short-term jobs offer good pay, flexible hours, paid training, and reimbursement for authorized work-related expenses, such as mileage incurred while conducting census work.

Census takers usually work in their own communities, going door-to-door, conducting brief personal interviews with neighbors, helping them to complete their census questionnaire. The positions require 20-40 hours per week, primarily in the evenings and on weekends.
