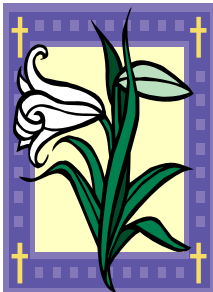


St. Anne Pilgrims
