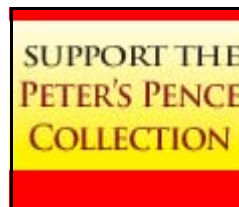
Last weekend's events honoring **Pat Durand** as she retires after seventeen years as St. Anne School Principal were wonderful celebrations.
