











<p><b>April 1</b> <b>EASTER SUNDAY</b>  Mass 8 am, 10 am</p>	<p><b>Fast &amp; Abstain</b> The Church calls all Catholics to observe Lent through fasting and abstinence from meat:</p> <p> <b>Abstinence</b> from meat for those 14 years of age and older on <b>Ash Wednesday</b> and the <b>Fridays of Lent</b>.</p> <p> <b>Fasting &amp; Abstinence</b> from meat on <b>Ash Wednesday</b> and <b>Good Friday</b> for those 18 - 59 years of age. Fasting consists of only one full meal with two smaller meals allowed if necessary. Those who, because of health, cannot fast from food are excused, but are encouraged to practice other forms of fasting.</p>
