St. Anne School Annual Auction

This event is well known to school families but in recent times not so much to the parish at large. We're not there yet but inching toward more regular times, a primer might be in order. This is the major fundraising event each year. Proceeds go toward the school operating budget, staff salaries and tuition assistance.

Each school family is being asked to contribute an item or experience – sports tickets, gift certificates, backyard BBQ, weekend getaways, original artwork and crafts. Families, friends and businesses (who may also be families and friends) are solicited for professional or personal sponsorships starting at \$250 and acknowledged in the program and all event marketing. Each year has a theme such as Kentucky Derby, Hollywood Nights, the Love Boat. This year is MARVEL at the Possibilities. Marvel not only refers to the extraordinary characters inhabiting comics and action movies but also to the promising and accomplished inhabitants of St. Anne School.

Events start with the opening of the online auction usually about a week ahead of the live auction, and concludes with the 21+ dinner and live auction in a formal outdoor tent on Saturday, April 30.
