The Transfiguration
Lk 9:28b-36

When you have completed Lectio Divina, transition to group sharing by providing copies of this week's readings as found on the webpage in facilitator resources. Ask each person to read through any one of the 1st reading, psalm or second reading. Invite each person to underline or anything that they have an emotional response to when they read it. Reread it now circle anything that they have an intellectual response to. There is no need for concern if they have no clear response. Pray asking for the Holy Spirit to continue speaking to us throughout the week through what we have circled, underlined, or even through the silence.

strengthen our wills through your Spirit.

Group Sharing Questions:

1. Taking the analogy of climbing a mountain, is there an experience you can share of making a long, strenuous journey and how it has blessed your life?
2. Reflecting on the sleepiness of the apostles, and looking at it as an analogy, how can you interpret drowsiness, sleep and waking up as significant moments in our Christian journey of conversion?
3. This is the second moment in scripture when the voice of God presents Jesus as his Son, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him". Can you imagine God calling your name now and saying, "This is (your name), my chosen son/daughter..." What would you like him to say next?
