

Finance Council:

- What is a finance council? According to the Code of Canon Law, each parish must have a finance council. The parish finance council is a consultative body composed of Catholic faithful who offer advice to the pastor in the administration of the parish's temporal goods. Their purpose includes conducting long-range financial planning with regard to funding operation and capital needs in the parish; providing financial analysis of current fiscal status reports and more.
- The members of St. Anne's Finance Council include: Brian Reisenauer, Emily English-Leake, Jeffrey Christianson, Mark Cristalli and Tom Polzin. Due to space, this month we'll introduce two members and next month the remaining three.
- Brian Reisenauer has been a parishioner since 2019 and in addition to being on the Finance Council has supported the parish through being a member on the St. Anne School Commission; 4th grade Gils Soccer Coach and 4th Grade Girls Basketball Coach. He is the CEO in training for Frontier Packaging, Inc. – a seafood packaging company. A fun fact about Brian is: "My mom gifted me an accordion and I've been trying to learn on my own. Prayer Assembly: During this week's Prayer Assembly, Mrs. Mullin talked about the Patron Saint of Immigrants, Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini. She was an Italian American religious sister who founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, serving and supporting Italian immigrants in New York City. Despite tremendous odds, Saint Frances established schools, orphanages, and hospitals, providing for the sick and poor. She serviced thousands of immigrants, established countless institutions. Her work spread throughout our nation, and the world. A true inspiration. Ms. Mullin closed with the Saint Frances Cabrini's Prayer for Immigrants:

Loving God,

You led St. Frances Cabrini around the world.

By her example, teach us concern for the stranger.

By her prayers, help us to see Christ in our immigrant Sisters and brothers

By your guidance and Mother Cabrini's inspiration may we love boldly and work tirelessly to correct injustice
