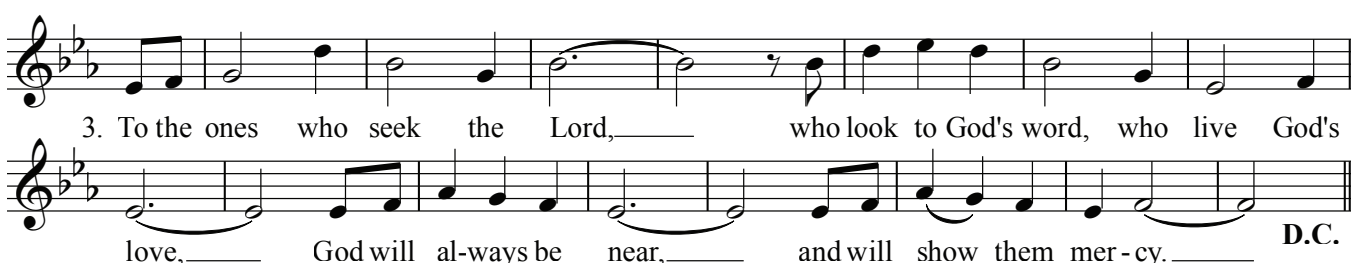
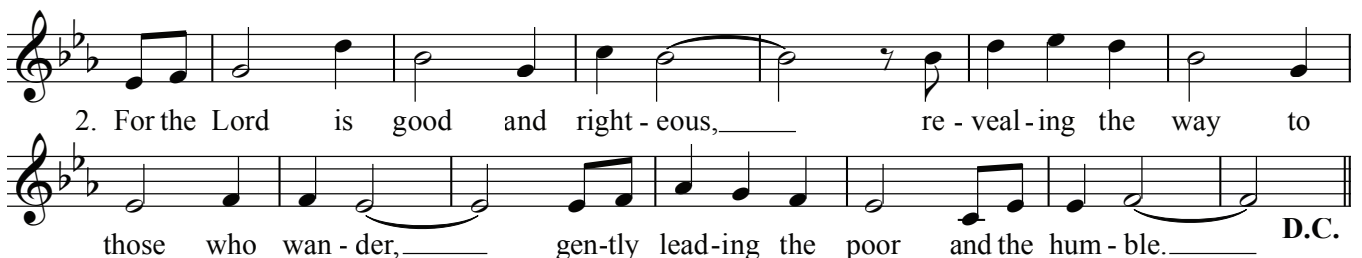


COMMUNION SONG.....Unless a Grain of Wheat


