

**HOMILY** 


PLEASE STAND PROFESSION of FAITH: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. 



> Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, says the Lord, and I will raise him up on the last day. cf. John 6:54






