

GATHERING SONG.....Take Up Your Cross




Take up your cross, the Sav - ior said, If you would my dis - ci - ple be;

we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God almighty Father.

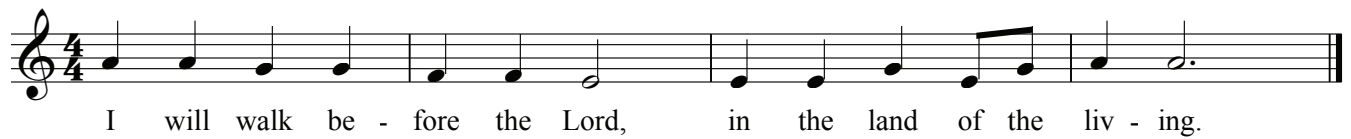
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of The Father,
