Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

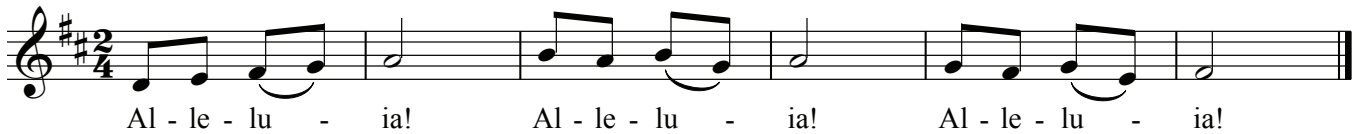
