



We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God almighty Father.



FIRST READING......Isaiah 53:10–11



PLEASE STAND PROFESSION of FAITH: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. 


