Born in Spain, in 1610 Fr Claver sailed to Cartagena, Colombia as a missionary, where he administered medicine, food, and aid to thousands of slaves. He worked tirelessly to deliver the message of God's love in the pursuit of human dignity. During his 40 years of ministry, he baptized an estimated 300,000 slaves.

One of Fr Clavers teachings was simply, "We must speak to them with our hands by giving, before we try to speak to them with our lips."


