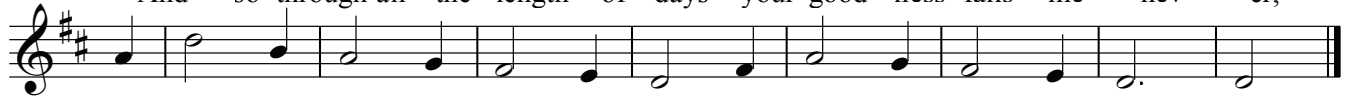

COMMUNION SONG.....In Christ Alone



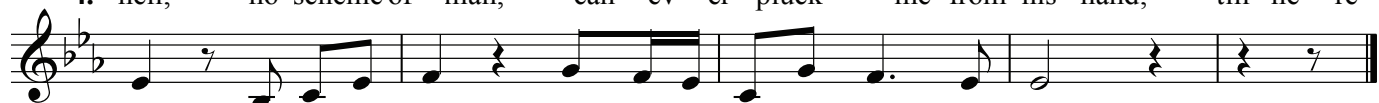
1. In Christ a-lone my hope is found, he is my light, my strength, my song: this cor-ner
