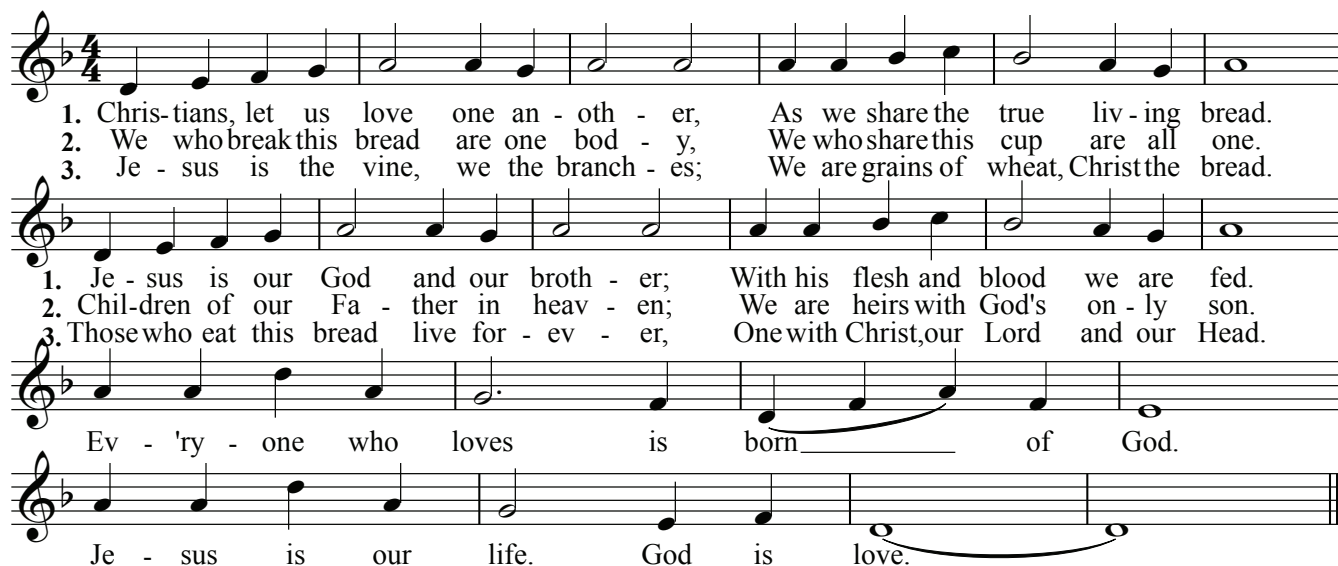
PROFESSION of FAITH:




