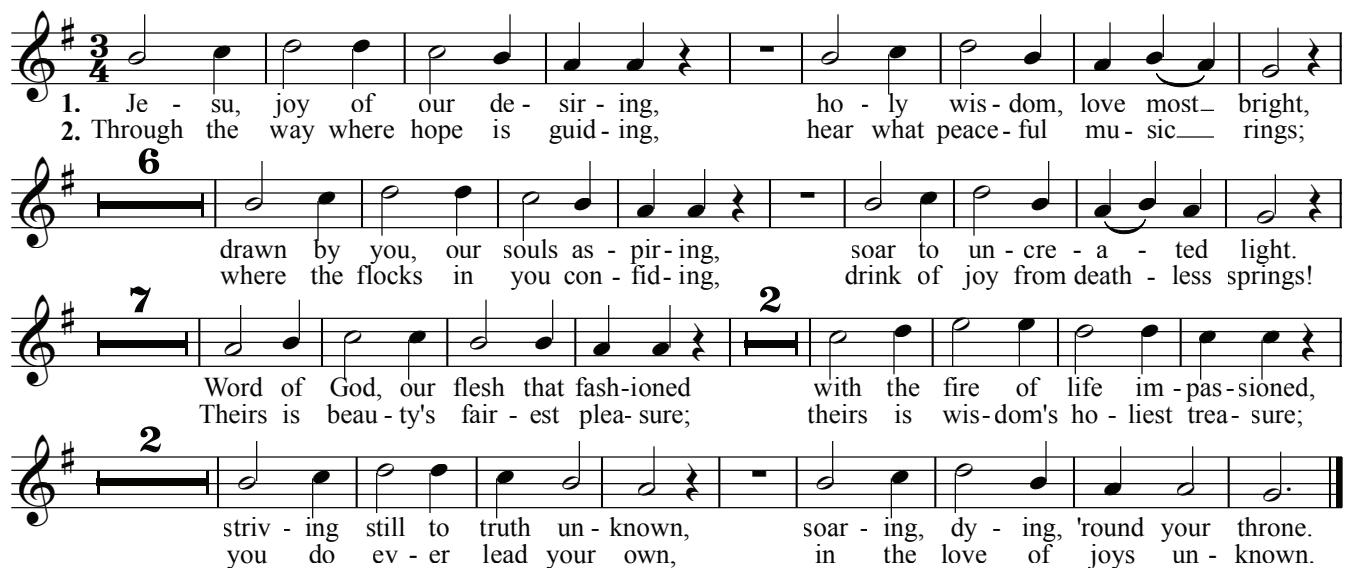
PROFESSION of FAITH:
