



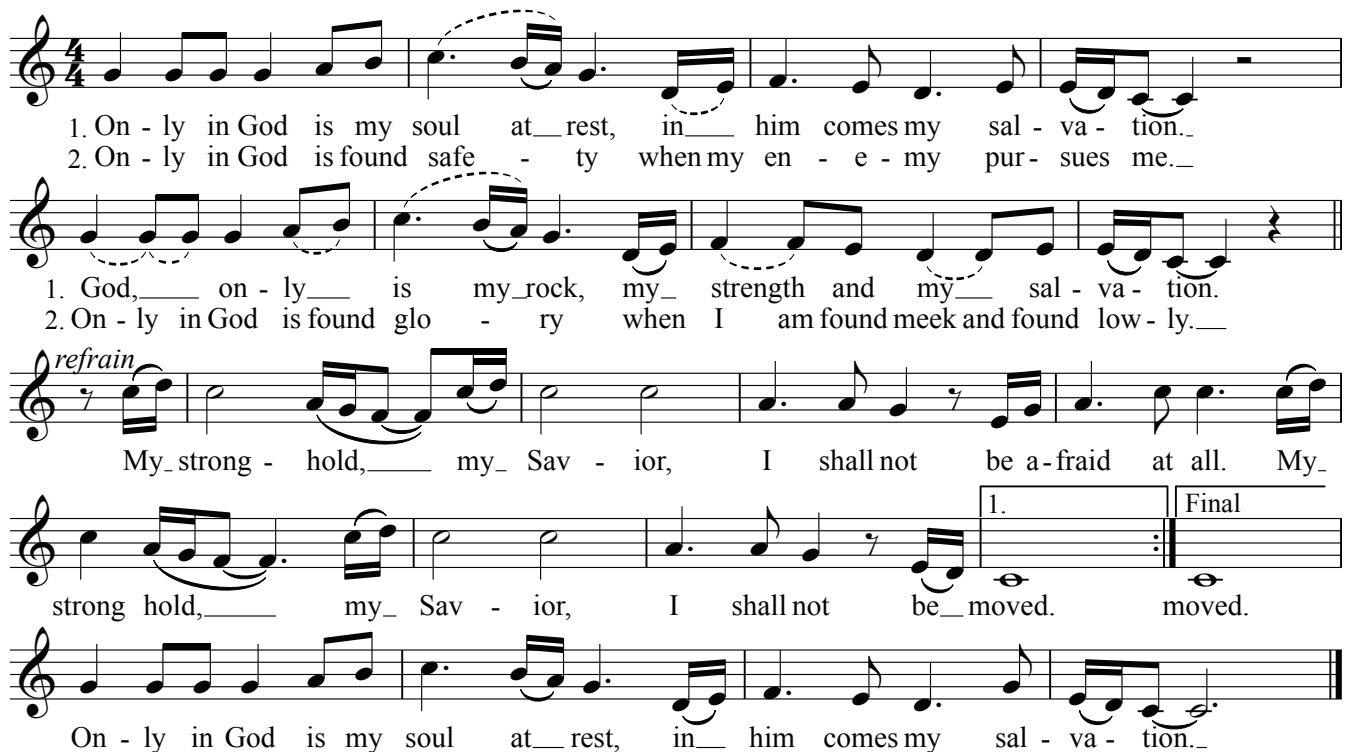
HOMILY




