
## The Exaltation of the Holy Cross

GATHERING SONG.....Take Up Your Cross





you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.**

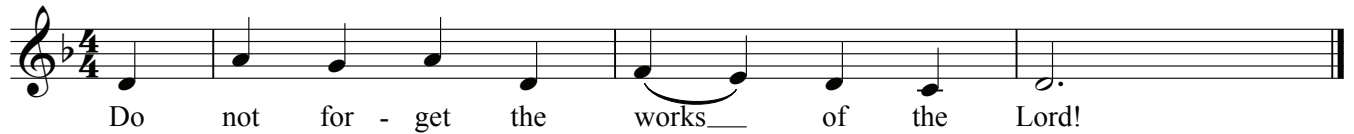

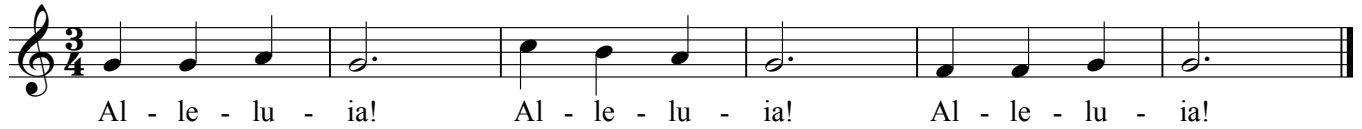
