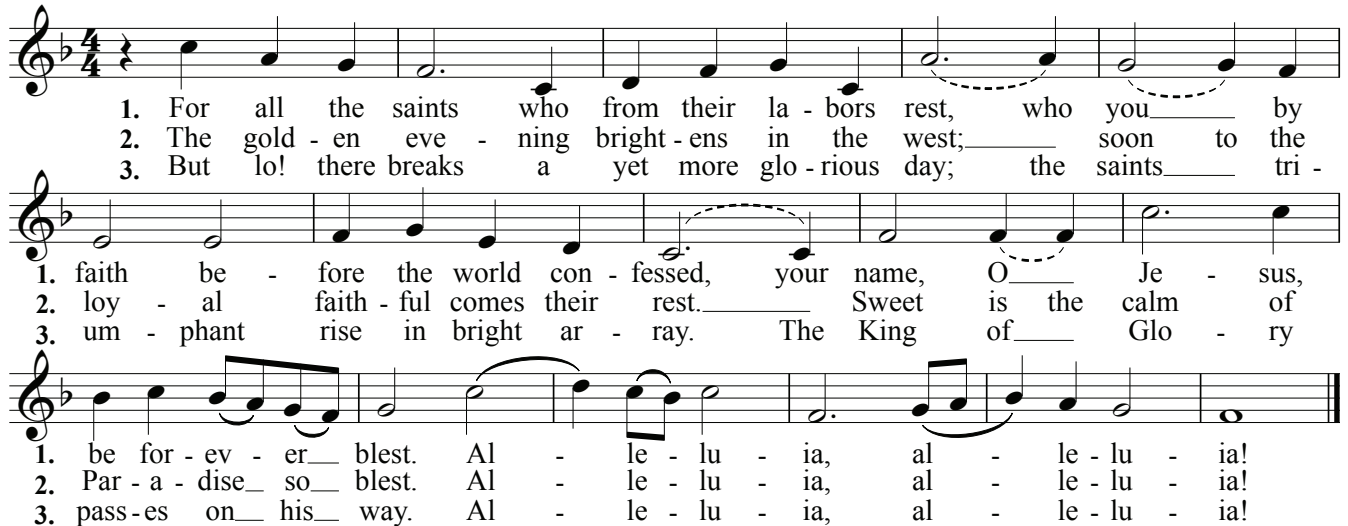
The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

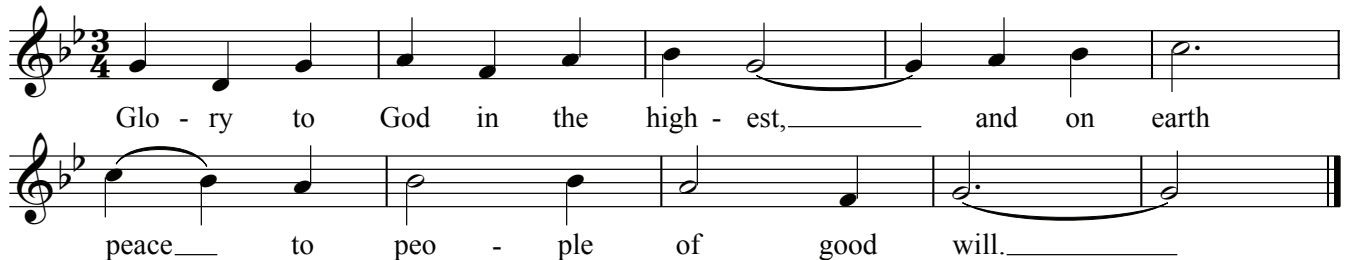
