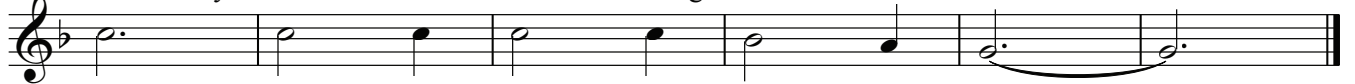

 4. hell, no scheme of man, can ev-er pluck me from his hand; till he re-


1. er my all in all, here in the love of Christ I stand.






